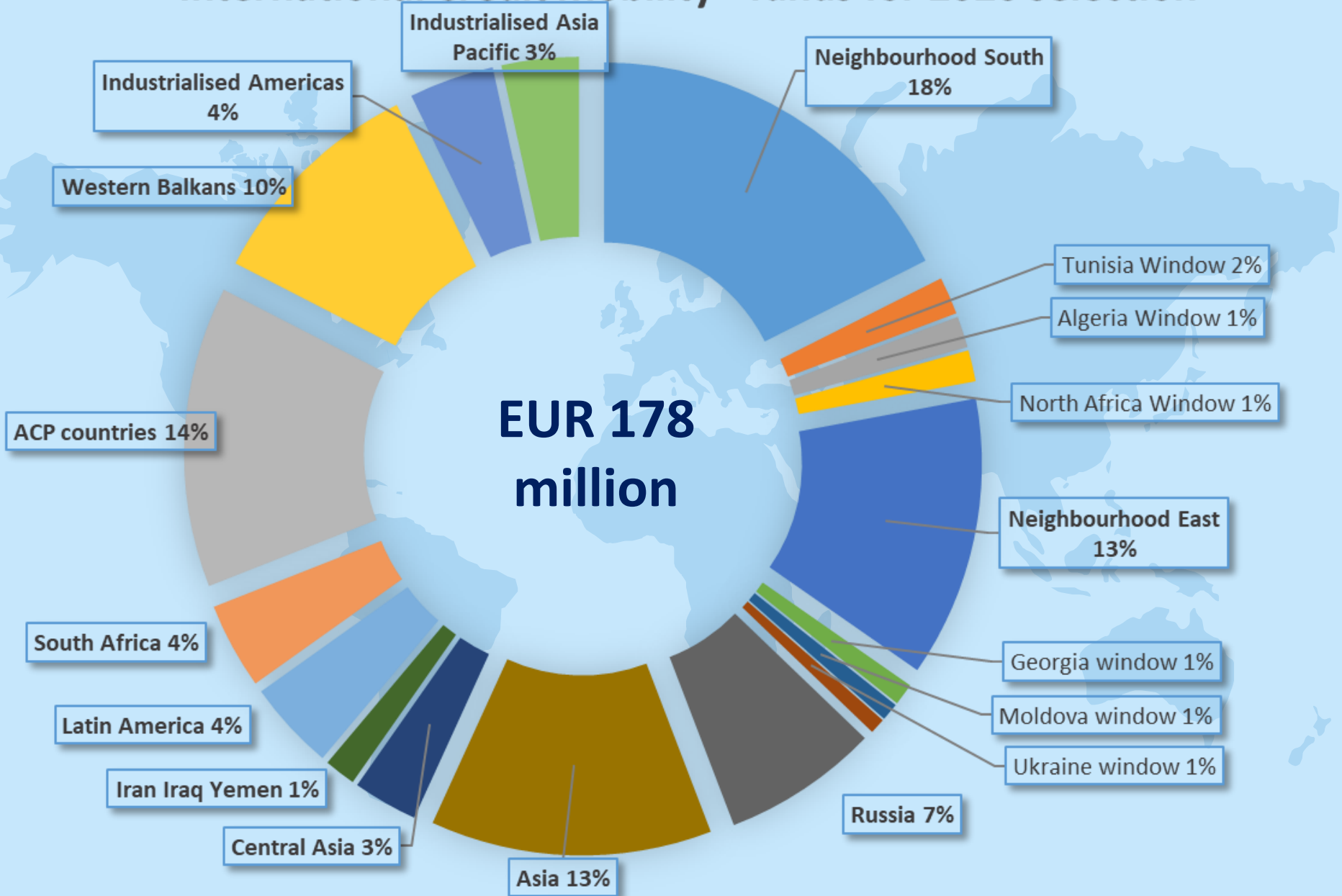
All 34 European Programme Countries have a budget

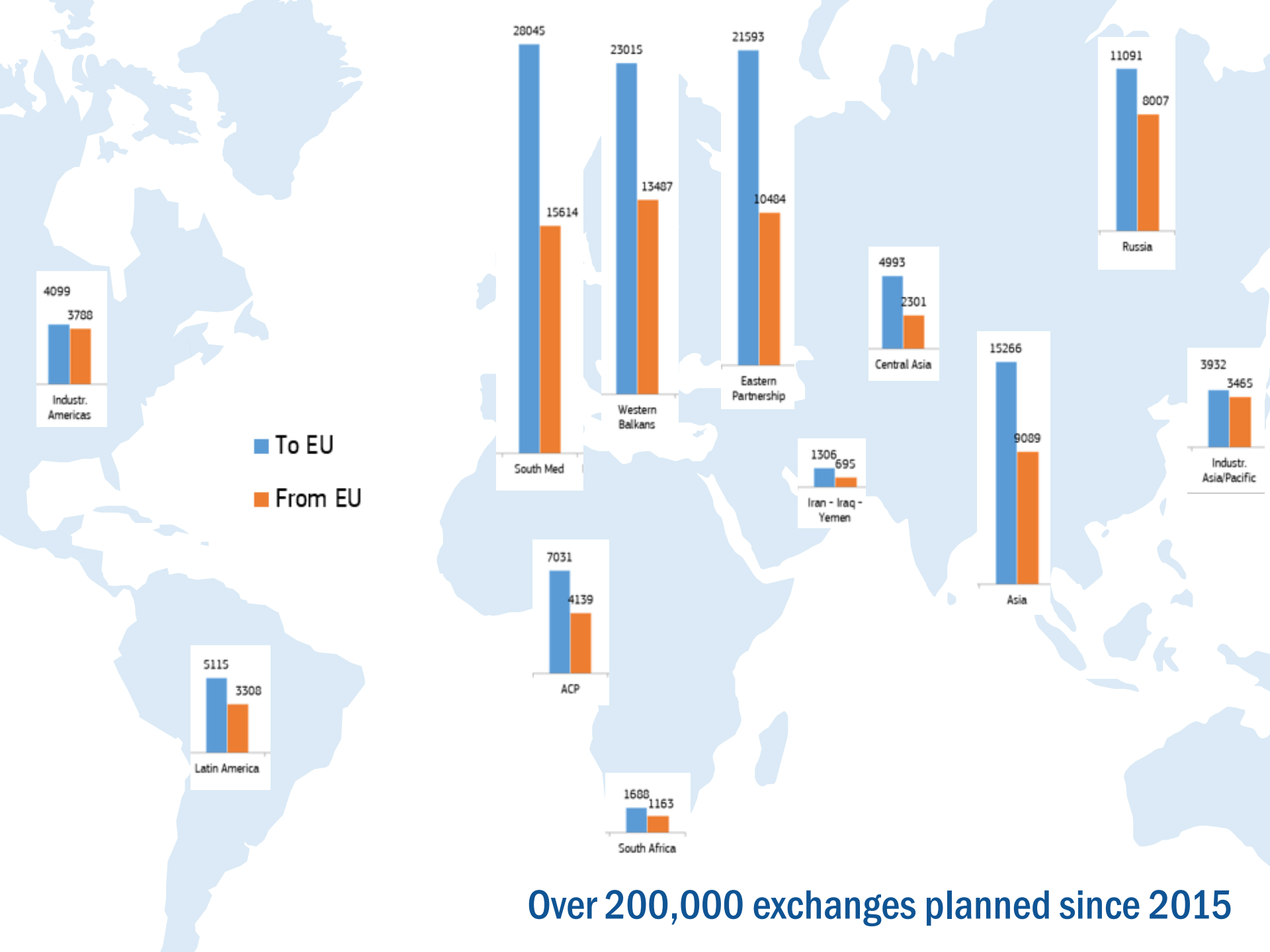
