

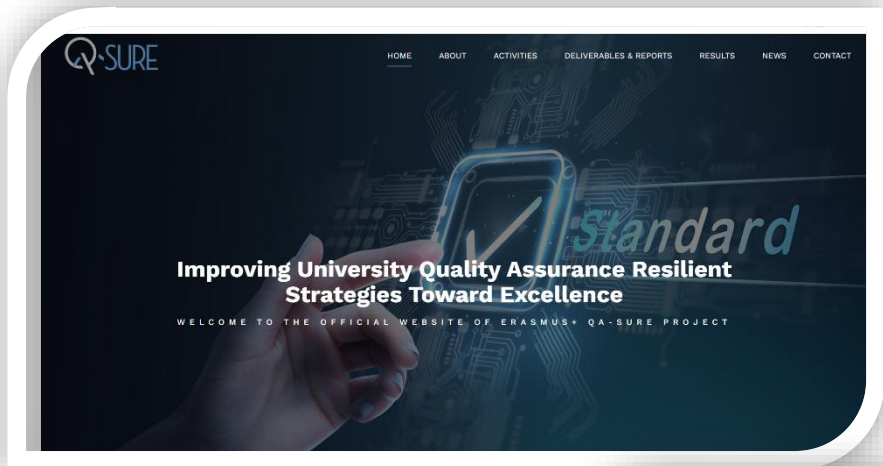

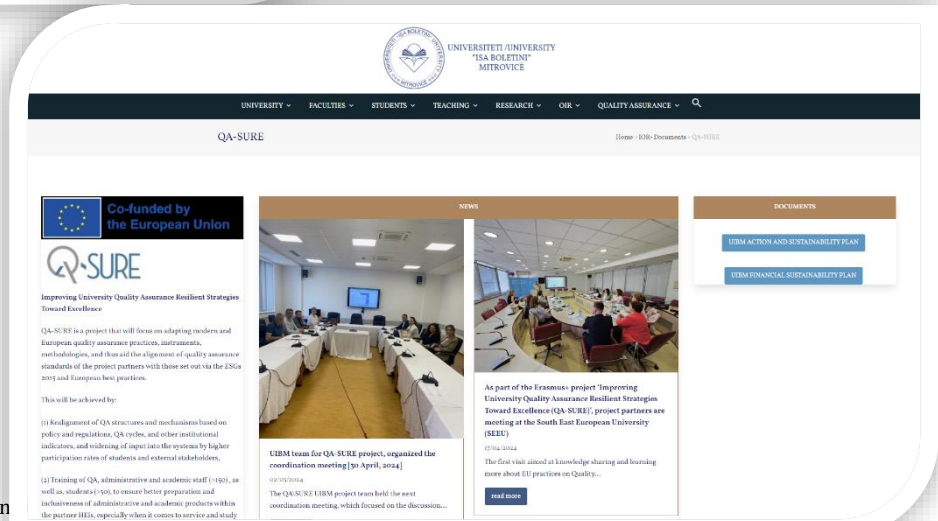

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Aims and Objectives of QA-SURE

General Objective

Establish/enhance and support quality assurance structures and mechanisms

- ✓ for effective management and operation through teaching and learning processes in the WB region,
- ✓ including deeper integration into European Higher Education Areas (EHEA).

Specific Objectives

- ✓ **SO1: Establish/enhance Quality Assurance Units/Offices** of HEIs in AL and KO and provide capacity building on quality assurance processes within networks of HEIs.
- ✓ **SO2: Training processes for designing study programs** of HEIs **based on labor market needs**, including the Action Plans for supporting the processes of QA in teaching, learning, and administration.

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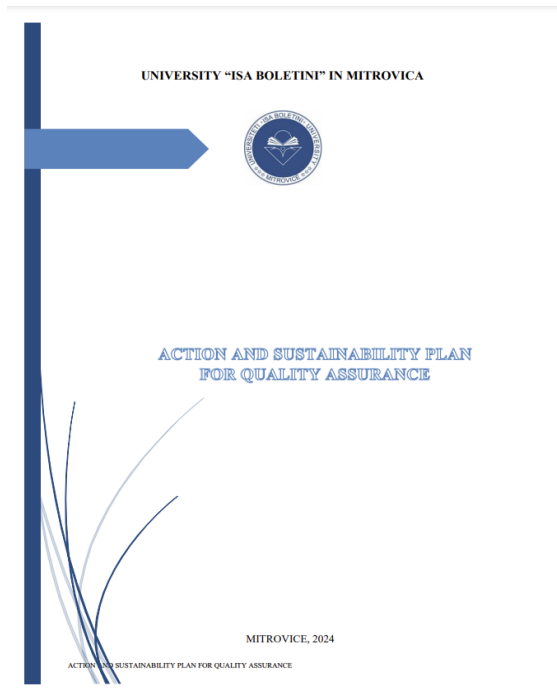
Project partner's meeting at the South East European University (SEEU)
